General Terms and Conditions of Participation

§1 Organizer

The organizer of the United LAN event is the United LAN organizing team (hereinafter referred to as "Organizer"). The event is held regularly in Meschede. The current event dates and locations are announced on the Organizer's official communication channels.

§2 Scope of Application

1. These terms and conditions apply to all visitors and participants of United LAN.
2. By registering and/or entering the event premises, participants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

§3 Eligibility and Protection of Minors

1. Participation is generally restricted to persons 18 years of age or older.
2. Minors aged 16 and older may only participate if they have a written consent form from their legal guardian and the legal provisions of the Youth Protection Act are complied with.
3. Games or content with age restrictions may only be used by appropriately authorized persons.

§4 Registration and Participation Agreement

1. Participation is subject to the official registration process of United LAN.
2. Upon successful registration and payment of the participation fee, a participation agreement is concluded between the participant and the Organizer.
3. There is no entitlement to participation. The organizer reserves the right to reject registrations without providing a reason.



§5 Participation Fees and Withdrawal

1. A participation fee may be charged. The amount will be disclosed during the registration process.
2. Cancellation of registration is generally permitted; however, there is no entitlement to a refund of the participation fee unless the organizer specifies otherwise.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to make tickets or participation slots non-transferable and to restrict their transfer.

§6 House Rules

1. The organizer retains the right to enforce house rules throughout the entire event.
2. Participants must always comply with the instructions of the organizer and event staff.
3. Violations of these terms and conditions, applicable law, or disruptive behaviour may result in exclusion from the event.
4. In the event of exclusion, there is no entitlement to a refund of the participation fee.

§7 Conduct at the Event

1. All participants are required to behave respectfully and considerately toward other participants and event staff.
2. Discrimination, harassment, violence, insults, or other inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.
3. Damage to property and disruption of the event are prohibited.

§8 Personal Devices and Network

1. Participants bring their hardware (e.g. consoles, controllers, computers, monitors, peripherals) entirely at their own risk.
2. Devices must be in proper working order and safe to operate.
3. The event network may only be used in accordance with statutory provisions.



4. The following are expressly prohibited:
 - Network attacks (e.g. DDoS, port scans, manipulation)
 - Distribution of illegal content
 - Copyright infringement or illegal downloads

§9 Prohibited Items and Animals

1. Bringing dangerous objects, weapons, illegal substances, or other prohibited items is not permitted.
2. Bringing pets or other animals onto the entire event premises is not permitted, unless legally recognized assistance animals are required.

§10 Smoking and Cannabis Consumption

1. Smoking is not permitted inside the event rooms.
2. Smoking is only permitted in the outdoor areas designated by the Organizer.
3. The consumption of cannabis is prohibited throughout the entire event premises. This applies regardless of the applicable legal regulations.
4. Violations of these rules may result in exclusion from the event.

§11 Liability

1. Participation is at the participant's own risk.
2. The Organizer is only liable for damages resulting from intentional or grossly negligent conduct by the Organizer or their agents.
3. For simple negligence, the Organizer is only liable in the event of a breach of material contractual obligations (cardinal obligations), and only up to the foreseeable, typical damage.
4. The Organizer accepts no liability for loss, theft, or damage to items brought by participants.



§12 Photo, Video, and Audio Recordings

1. Photo, video, and audio recordings may be made during the event.
2. By participating, participants consent to such recordings being used for reporting, documentation, and public relations purposes (e.g. website, social media).

§13 Data Protection

1. Personal data is processed solely for the purpose of organizing and conducting the event.
2. Processing is carried out in accordance with applicable data protection regulations, in particular the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

§14 Changes and Cancellation of the Event

1. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the program, schedule, or timetable, provided these are reasonable.
2. Should the event need to be cancelled due to force majeure or organizational reasons, any participation fee already paid will be refunded.
3. Further claims do not exist.

§15 Final Provisions

1. The laws of the Federal Republic of Germany apply.
2. Should any provision of these Terms and Conditions be or become invalid in whole or in part, the validity of the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected.
3. The invalid provision shall be replaced by a legally permissible provision that most closely approximates the economic purpose of the original provision.
